II. Objective:

- The installation of the CCTV aims to protect the priceless museum collections and its associated documentation records, conservation reports and photographs from unexpected causes such as fire, theft, natural disaster and accidental damages.
- 2. It also aims to comply with the safety requirements of the National Building Code
- To ensure that this equipment will be properly maintained due to its importance and value.

III. Scope of Work

Visual Inspection

- a. Inspect all camera pictures for optical image quality.
- b. Clean all camera lenses and housing glasses.
- c. Check all lens field of views and adjust if necessary according to the requirement of the National Museum.
- d. Ensure that camera/lens focus and auto iris are adjusted properly.
- e. Ensure that Interior of the camera is clean and dry.
- f. Check operation of pan tilt, zoom focus.

2. Wire and Video Cable

- a. Check connectors and cable entry points for loose wiring. Check wiring and cable harnesses for wear and fry.
- Check to make sure cable is transmitting an adequate video signal and free from interference and distortions.
- Checking of connectors, re-crimping and re-tightening to avoid video interference

3. Control equipment

- a. Carry out DVR recording test.
- Visual inspection of system components to check any damage or wear.
- Verify quality of recorded video.
- Test remote signaling equipment functionality, where applicable.
- e. Carry out video calibration tests on all connected monitors.
- f. System check on recorder and its hard disk
- g. Perform video and audio (if applicable) signal calibration test.
- h. Clean Computers:

- Clean all monitor screens, control panels, and keyboards with a diluted cleaning solution
- j. Carry out maintenance procedures which are standard in the industry;
- k. Return the system to normal operational Status.

4. Frequency of Maintenance

- Inspection of the CCTV system and its associated components shall be done at least once a month for the National Museum Buildings located in Metro Manila.
- The service Provider shall be available on call 24/7.
- c. Unlimited remote engineer diagnostics, changes and system monitoring

5. Preventive Maintenance Supervision

a. Supervision of preventive maintenance shall be jointly implemented by the Facilities Management and Development Section of the Restoration and Engineering Division and the ICT Committee.

6. Contractor/Service Provider/Employed Technician

- Service providers should have legal, technical and financial capability to implement the above-mentioned project.
- The principal business of the prospective Service Provider must be related to the maintenance, distribution, and installation of security/surveillance systems.
- c. Prospective service provider must be in the business of maintenance, distribution, and installation of security/surveillance systems for at least 3 months
- Return the system to normal operational status
- Prospective service provider must be an authorized servicing agent for the IP Cameras and Switches to be maintained.
- f. The prospective service provider shall provide 24/7 on-call and phone support for emergency breakdown of hardware (They shall provide a certificate/letter to this effect).
- g. Prospected service provider shall be able to prove equipment (testing equipment, ladder, cleaning equipment and materials) to ensure the proper implementation of the project.
- h. Subcontracting or assignment of any portion of the Project is prohibited.
- Prospective service provider must have a Certificate of Training for its employees issued by the manufacturer of the Network Video Recorder to be maintained.
- Prospective service provider must have a Certificate of Training for its employees issued by the manufacturer of the network Video Recorder to be maintained.
- Service provider should provide spare and service units to serve as temporary replacement for damage cameras (must be compatible with the system used by the National Museum).



- Technicians employed by service provider should carry range of tools, test equipment, suitable spares and other gadgets to enable them to perform their functions their f satisfactorily.
- m. Service provider should orient its employees to assign in the National Museum about laws related to data protection and privacy and other pertinent laws and that infringement of the same shall be the Service provider's and its employees' liability.
- n. After every inspection, the service provider should submit maintenance reports with recommendations using acceptable format or using the format that the National Museum may provide.
- Employees of Service Provider should wear uniform and carry a valid means of identification with photograph and signature of the bearer, company name, and date of expiry.

IV. PROCUREMENT PROCESS

Procurement of services for the contractor or service provider for the abovementioned project shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Government Procurement Reform Act (R.A. 9184) and its revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

V. SUBMITALS

The contractor shall furnish ICT with Service Report.

VI. SOURCE OF FUND

Budget is available and shall be chargeable against General Fund repair and Maintenance for a monthly period.

VII. APPROVED BUDGET FOR CONTRACT
