

**BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING MMM PRECISION INSTRUMENTS TRADING WITH
SECOND LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE CONTRACT,
PROCUREMENT OF HIGH-EFFICIENCY PARTICULATE AIR (HEPA) FILTER PURIFIER AS
COVID-19 RESPONSE PROJECT OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES
(NMP) THROUGH ITS SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEE (SHC), RECOMMENDING
APPROVAL OF AWARD**

RESOLUTION No. 2021 - 70

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines (NMP), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), intends to acquire goods from a bonafide merchant, by means of Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations, R.A. 9184 (Two Failed Biddings) to undertake the above-mentioned project;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **One Million Seven Hundred Sixty-Four Thousand One Hundred Pesos (Php 1,764,100.00)** chargeable against the 2020 Continuing Fund;

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid was posted and published in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPs), NMP Website and in the BAC Bulletin Board on 4 October 2021, pursuant to Sec. 21 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, five (5) observers from various government offices and private organizations were invited to witness the bidding process, viz: Commission on Audit (COA), Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Institute of Politics & Governance, Inc., and Museum Employees Organization (MUSEO);

WHEREAS, a Preliminary Conference was held on 8 October 2021 at the Old Civil Service Building, Padre Burgos Street, Manila to discuss all matters pertaining to the aforementioned project, i.e. Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Bidding Documents and others;

WHEREAS, the Committee conducted the Submission and Opening of Bids on 13 October 2021, at the Old Civil Service Building, Padre Burgos Street, Manila, participated by two (2) bidders, namely: Krypton International Resources Sales & Services, Inc., (Krypton, for brevity), and MMM Precision Instruments Trading (MMM, for brevity)

WHEREAS, the bids from the eligible bidders, passed the preliminary examination by the Committee of the Technical and Financial Proposals based on the presence of the submitted documents as against the checklist of required documents, and consequently, the Committee read and recorded their bids as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) subjected Krypton's proposal to post qualification evaluation, being the 1st lowest calculated bid (1st LCB). It was post- disqualified and found to be not responsive;

WHEREAS, through NMPBAC Resolution No. 2021-63 the BAC declaring the post-disqualification of the 1st LCB, the Chairperson, with the concurrence of the Committee members has notified in writing the Bidder with 1st LCB of its post- disqualification on 29 October 2021. Said Bidder did not file a Motion for Reconsideration within three (3) calendar days upon the Bidder's receipt of said written notice;

WHEREAS, the TWG proceeded with the post-qualification of MMM Precision Instruments Trading being the Second Lowest Calculated Bid (2nd LCB). After thorough and proper evaluation, it was confirmed compliant with all the technical, financial and post-qualification requirements and conditions set for the aforementioned project and has been found to be responsive;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommend as we hereby recommend that the project, **PROCUREMENT OF HIGH-EFFICIENCY PARTICULATE AIR (HEPA) FILTER PURIFIER AS COVID-19 RESPONSE PROJECT OF THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES (NMP) THROUGH ITS SAFETY AND HEALTH COMMITTEE (SHC)**, be awarded to **MMM Precision Instruments Trading**, with a contract amount of **One Million Five Hundred Ninety-Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Pesos (Php 1,598,900.00)**.


