



BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING FJ CONSTRUCTION & ENTERPRISES WITH SECOND LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE CONTRACT, REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF ANGONO-BINANGONAN PETROGLYPHS SITE MUSEUM AND SATELLITE OFFICE, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF AWARD

RESOLUTION No. 2021 - 72

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines (NMP), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), intends to acquire, by means of Public Bidding, a bonafide contractor for the project mentioned above;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **Three Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 3,500,000.00)** chargeable against General Fund FY 2021;

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid was posted and published in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), NMP Website and in the BAC Bulletin Board on 21 September 2021, pursuant to Sec. 21 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, nine (9) observers from various government offices and private organizations were invited to witness the bidding process, viz: Commission on Audit (COA), Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Institute of Politics & Governance, Inc., Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE), United Architects of the Philippines (UAP), Philippine Constructors Association Inc., Philippine Institute of Civil Engineers (PICE), and Museum Employees Organization (MUSEO);

WHEREAS, a Pre-Bidding Conference was held on 20 September 2021 at the Old Civil Service Building, Padre Burgos Street, Manila to discuss all matters pertaining to the aforementioned project, i.e. Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Bidding Documents and others;

WHEREAS, the Committee conducted the Submission and Opening of Bids on 6 October 2021, at the Old Civil Service Building, Padre Burgos Street, Manila, attended and participated by two (2) bidders, namely: FJ Construction & Enterprises and Padavela Business Development and Consultancy Corporation;

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the financial components of the bids determined as "passed," the bidders were ranked according to their bid submissions, as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) subjected Padavela Business Development and Consultancy Corporation to Post Qualification Evaluation, being the 1st lowest calculated bid (1st LCB) was post-disqualified and not responsive;

WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 2021-61 (attached as Annex A) the BAC declared the disqualification of Padavela Business Development and Consultancy Corporation (PADAVELA), who received its disqualification notice on October 18, 2021. Padavela filed a Motion for Reconsideration (MR) on October 20, 2021 which was within the three (3) calendar days to file such motion;

WHEREAS, notwithstanding the pending request for reconsideration from the Padavela, the BAC initiated the same post-qualification process to FJ Construction & Enterprises, the bidder with the Second Lowest Calculated Bid (2nd LCB):

WHEREAS, as per attached Post-Qualification Evaluation Report, FJ Construction & Enterprises the 2nd bidder with the LCB, after thorough and proper evaluation, confirmed compliant with all the technical, financial and post-qualification requirements and conditions set for the aforementioned project;

WHEREAS, after deliberation, the Committee issued in Resolution No. 2021-69 (attached as Annex B) denying Padavela's MR on November 9, 2021, with notice that the decision of the BAC may be protested in writing to the Head of the Procuring Entity which must be filed within seven (7) calendar days;

WHEREAS, there being no protest filed after the lapse of seven (7) days, the BAC proceeded to complete the post-qualification of the FJ Construction & Enterprises and has been found to be responsive;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommend as we hereby recommend that the project, **REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF ANGONO-BINANGONAN PETROGLYPHS SITE MUSEUM AND SATELLITE OFFICE**, be awarded to **FJ Construction & Enterprises**, with a contract amount of **Three Million Three Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Seventy-Nine Pesos and Four Centavos (Php 3,359,279.04)**.


