

**BAC RESOLUTION DECLARING EURO JANITORIAL SERVICES & CO., WITH
LOWEST CALCULATED AND RESPONSIVE BID FOR THE CONTRACT LOT 1:
PROCUREMENT OF JANITORIAL SERVICE FOR THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE
PHILIPPINES (NMP) COMPLEX FISCAL YEAR 2022, RECOMMENDING APPROVAL OF
AWARD**

RESOLUTION No. 2022 - 10

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines (NMP), through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), intends to acquire, by means of Public Bidding, a bonafide merchant for the project mentioned above;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **Thirty-Two Million Two Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Seven Hundred Eight Pesos (Php 32,256,708.00)** chargeable against General Fund FY 2022;

WHEREAS, an Invitation to Bid was posted and published in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPs), NMP Website and in the BAC Bulletin Board on 22 December 2021, pursuant to Sec. 21 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, five (5) observers from various government offices and private organizations were invited to witness the bidding process, viz: Commission on Audit (COA), Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Institute of Politics & Governance, Inc., and Museum Employees Organization (MUSEO);

WHEREAS, a Pre-Bidding Conference was held on 19 January 2022 at the Old Civil Service Building, Padre Burgos Street, Manila to discuss all matters pertaining to the aforementioned project, i.e. Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Bidding Documents and others;

WHEREAS, the Committee conducted the Submission and Opening of Bids on 9 February 2022, at the Old Civil Service Building, Padre Burgos Street, Manila, attended and participated by two (2) bidders, namely:

- (1) CBIL PHILIPPINES INTERNATIONAL INC.; and
- (2) EURO JANITORIAL SERVICES & CO.

WHEREAS, all bidders passed the eligibility, technical, and financial check performed by the Committee using the pass or fail non-discretionary criteria for evaluation, the BAC read and recorded their bids as follows:

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) subjected CBII PHILIPPINES INTERNATIONAL INC. to Post Qualification Evaluation, being the 1st lowest calculated bidder.

WHEREAS, the TWG finds CBII Philippines International, Inc. post disqualified based on the following grounds:

1. The submitted SLCC is NOT similar to the project. Paragraph XV (1) of the TOR provides that the Agency should have at least five (5) years continuous experience within the last five (5) years to a museum and galleries or similar institution that exhibits or display collections to what the museum have in its display. The terms similar should be read in relation to the aforesaid provision of the TOR.
2. The note in the Bill of Quantities only excludes Equipment. Since in the bid proposal Supplies, Materials and Equipment are in zero (0), the BOQ should also clearly indicate that the exclusion applies to all Supplies, Materials and Equipment Otherwise, they should be included in the bid proposal since their specific computations are included in the bid documents without adequate reservation.

WHEREAS, a notice of post disqualification, dated 24 February 2022, was forwarded to CBII:

WHEREAS, a Motion for Reconsideration dated 28 February 2022 by CBII was forwarded to the National Museum appealing to reconsider the post disqualification based on the following grounds:

1. The project that is up for bid basically involves janitorial services, which is similar to the job subject of our SLCC, Metro Rail Transit 3 that had a contract price of Php118,875,681.00, which amount is more than 50% of the Authorized Budget for the Contract (ABC).
2. CBII's bid documents show that they placed "0" bid for supplies, materials and equipment. Hence the sum of Php1,379.77 for supplies, materials and equipment stated in the TWG's computation in comparison with our bid proposal is baseless.

WHEREAS, after deliberation and in accordance with the findings provided for by the TWG, the Committee issued Resolution No. 2022-07 dated 3 March 2022 denying the motion for reconsideration filed by CBII:

WHEREAS, a letter dated 4 March 2022 was forwarded to CBII denying their request for reconsideration:

WHEREAS, as per attached Post-Qualification Evaluation Report submitted by its TWG, EURO JANITORIAL SERVICES & CO., as the 2nd LCB, has complied with all the technical, financial and post-qualification requirements and conditions set for the aforementioned project:

WHEREAS, after no protest in writing was filed by CBII, the BAC proceeded to complete the post-qualification of the Bidder with 2nd LCB and has been found to be responsive;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommend as we hereby recommend that the project, **LOT 1: PROCUREMENT OF JANITORIAL SERVICE FOR THE NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES (NMP) COMPLEX FISCAL YEAR 2022**, be awarded to **EURO JANITORIAL SERVICES & CO.**, with a contract amount of **Twenty-Seven Million Six Hundred Ten Thousand Ninety-Six Pesos and Eighty Centavos (Php27,610,096.80).**
