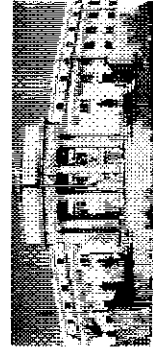

CONTRACT AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this FEB 26 2024 day of 2024 between **NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES, National Museum Complex, Rizal Park, Manila, 1000, Philippines** (hereinafter called “the MUSEUM”) of the one part and **ANY NETWORK SYSTEMS INC., 300 Brgy. Tejeros, J.P. Rizal, Makati City** (hereinafter called “the Supplier”) of the other part;

WHEREAS, the Museum invited Bids for certain goods and ancillary services, particularly **Supply, Delivery and Set-up of Twenty (20) PC Kiosks bundled with UPS and Digital Signage System**, and has accepted a Bid by the Supplier for the supply of those goods and services in the sum of **Seven Million Three Hundred Sixty Thousand Pesos (PHP 7,360,000.00)** (hereinafter called “the Contract Price”).

WHEREAS, the drafting and preparation of the Contract was conducted on **February 8, 2024**.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:


1. In this Agreement words and expressions shall have the same meanings as are respectively assigned to them in the Conditions of Contract referred to.
2. The following documents as required by the 2016 revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184 shall be deemed to form and be read and construed as integral part of this Agreement, viz.:
 - i. Philippine Bidding Documents (PBDs);
 - i. Schedule of Requirements;
 - ii. Technical Specifications;
 - iii. General and Special Conditions of Contract; and
 - iv. Supplemental or Bid Bulletins, if any
 - ii. Winning bidder’s bid, including the Eligibility requirements, Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents or statements submitted; Bid form, including all the documents/statements contained in the Bidder’s bidding envelopes, as annexes, and all other documents submitted (e.g., Bidder’s response to request for clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid, if any, resulting from the Procuring Entity’s bid evaluation;
 - iii. Performance Security;
 - iv. Notice of Award of Contract; and the Bidder’s conforme thereto; and
 - v. Other contract documents that may be required by existing laws and/or the Procuring Entity concerned in the PBDs. **Winning bidder agrees that additional contract documents or information prescribed by the GPPB that are subsequently required for submission after the contract execution, such as the Notice to Proceed, Variation Orders, and Warranty Security, shall likewise form part of the Contract.**

3. In consideration for the sum of Seven Million Three Hundred Sixty Thousand Pesos (PHP 7,360,000.00) or such other sums as may be ascertained, ANY NETWORK SYSTEMS INC. agrees to the Supply, Delivery and Set-up of Twenty (20) PC Kiosks bundled with UPS and Digital Signage System in accordance with his/her/its Bid.

4. The NATIONAL MUSEUM OF THE PHILIPPINES agrees to pay the above-mentioned sum in accordance with the terms of the Bidding.

5. It is understood that the Supplier is bound to fulfill all the requirements and conditions provided in this contract and as such, the conditions on Liquidated damages in accordance with Sec. 68 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of R.A. 9184 shall be strictly implemented.







- Availability of much more museums related information that can be displayed with two-dimensional media
- Customized information, allowing people to navigate to their area of interest
- Interactive Map feature – featuring galleries, news and events, maps, etc.
- View point interactive kiosk shall provide all of these advantages, and also the ability to connect with people already seeking information for events, products and that may be of interest to them.

1. The Supplier/ Bidder Should at least have 10 years of collaborative partnership in the Digital Signage Industry.
2. The Supplier/ Bidder/service provider must have been in the market for at least 10 years.
3. UPS Product offer must be an international brand with at least 10 years presence in the Philippines as of date of this bid.
4. The Supplier /Contractor should provide training with certificates regarding management, troubleshooting and configuration of Interactive Kiosks that are installed
5. UPS Brand offer must have an international office abroad and at least (1) authorized representative here in the Philippines to contact for clarification related with the bid. Representatives must be employed by the principal product brand to offer.
6. UPS Brand manufacturing facility must have been certified with the following standards: ISO 9001, ISO 14001, ISO 45001, GB/T 45001
7. UPS Product model to offer must have the following certifications: CE Electromagnetic, CE Low Voltage, and RoHS Compliant
8. The Supplier/ Bidder must be an authorized dealer/reseller of brand to offer and must submit the following certifications: Manufacturer's Authorization Form, Product Authenticity Certification, Authorized Dealer Certification

The Approved Budget of the Contract (ABC) is Seven Million and Four Hundred Thousand Pesos (7,400,000.00).

The delivery of the units shall be within Sixty (60) calendar days from receipt of Purchase Order or Notice to Proceed.

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

65% - Delivery and Acceptance of Thirteen (13) Units in the NMP Complex
35% - Delivery and Acceptance of Seven (7) Units in Selected NMP Regional Museums

WARRANTY: The Contractor shall provide **One (1) year** warranty reckoned from the date of completion and acceptance of Interactive Kiosk and Digital Signage Player. Also the contract should have 24-48 hours response time for service within Metro Manila. Form of warranty shall be as specified in Section 62.1 of the IRR of R.A. 9184, the Government Procurement Reform Act and its Implementing Rules and Regulations.

When the contractor fails to satisfactorily deliver goods under the contract within the specified delivery schedule, inclusive of duly granted time extensions, if any, the contractor shall be liable for damages for the delay and shall pay the procuring entity liquidated damages, not by way of penalty, an amount equal to 1/10 of 1% of the cost of the delayed contract scheduled for every day of delay until such goods are finally delivered and accepted by the procuring entity concerned. In no case shall the sum of the liquidated damages exceed 10% of the total contract price, in which the procuring entity concerned may rescind the contract and impose appropriate sanctions over and above the liquidated damages.


PRE-TERMINATION CLAUSE:

The contract is effective on the date indicated in the NTP and shall remain in full force for **(DURATION)** or until terminated by either party (NMP or Contractor) upon prior written notice by either party. Termination process shall follow the prescribed procedure under IRR-A R.A. 9184.

The NMP reserves the right to pre-terminate the contract by serving written notice on the Contractor. If the Contractor does not appeal or seek reconsideration of the decision to pre-terminate within Fifteen (15) calendar days from receipt of the notice, the contract is deemed terminated. The grounds for the termination of the contract by the NMP include but not limited to the following:


1. Violation(s) of any of the terms and conditions of the Contract; and




