

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-052

Leasing of Photocopiers for NMP Complex

WHEREAS, the National Museum of the Philippines, through the Bids and Awards Committee, intends to acquire, by means of Public Bidding, a bonafide contractor for the project mentioned above;

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is Two Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (PHP 2,500,000.00) chargeable against General Fund FY 2025;

WHEREAS, on 31 May 2025 an Invitation to Bid was posted and published in the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS), National Museum of the Philippines' website and in the BAC Bulletin Board, pursuant to Sec. 21 of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184;

WHEREAS, five (5) observers from various government offices and private organizations were invited to witness the bidding process, viz: Commission on Audit (COA); National Historical Commission of the Philippines (NHCP), Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Institute of Politics & Governance, Inc., Museum Employees Organization (MUSEO);

WHEREAS, on **10 June 2025**, a Pre-Bidding Conference was held to discuss all matters pertaining to the aforementioned project, i.e. Terms of Reference, Scope of Work, Bidding Documents, and others;

WHEREAS, on 26 June 2025, the Committee conducted the Submission and Opening of Bids, attended and participated by a two (2) bidders, namely:

- (1) CopierOnline Philippines Inc;
- (2) Multibiz International Corporation

WHEREAS, all bidders passed the technical, and financial components based on R.A. 9184 as checked by the Committee using the "pass or fail" non-discretionary criteria for evaluation;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 34, Rule X of the 2016 Revised IRR of R.A. 9184, the Technical Working Group (TWG) subjected CopierOnline Philippines Inc. to Post Qualification Evaluation, being the Lowest Calculated Bid after the bid evaluation conducted by the Committee;

WHEREAS, the TWG, after thorough and proper evaluation, confirmed and declared CopierOnline Philippines Inc. as post-qualified and responsive to the requirement set for the aforementioned project;

NOW, THEREFORE, WE, the members of the Bids and Awards Committee hereby recommends as we hereby RECOMMEND that the project Leasing of Photocopiers for NMP Complex be awarded to CopierOnline Philippines Inc., with a contract amount of One Million Eight Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (PHP 1,825,200.00).
